- 1. The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
- 2. The submission file is in a (.doc), (.docx), or (.rtf) format.
- 3. All URL addresses in the text (e.g., http://pkp.sfu.ca) are activated and ready to click.
- 4. The text is single-spaced; the text employs italics, rather than underlining (except with URL addresses); and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, **OR** at the end of the manuscript with appropriate placeholders in the body.
- 5. The text has had the authors' names removed. If an author is cited, "Author" and year are used in the bibliography and footnotes, instead of author's name, paper title, etc. The author's name has also been removed from the document's Properties, which in Microsoft Word is found in the File menu.
- 6. The Author has submitted or will presently be submitting a completed Author Agreement form.
- 7. The Submitting Author conducted the research to be submitted while studying as an undergraduate at Emory College.
- 8. The Submitting Author is the primary author of the submission.
- 9. The author has retained the **original versions of all pictures, figures, graphs, and diagrams** in the event that layout should need to contact him or her during the editing process.
- 10. The author has submitted a hi-quality professional headshot for publication along with his or her article as a supplementary file.
- 11. The author has submitted definitions for all key terms and jargon as a supplemental file in .DOC, .DOCX, or .RTF format
